# Setup Guide

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### In This Guide

This guide provides instructions for installing the LearnMate Content Viewer. LearnMate courses can be installed only once the Content Viewer is installed.

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### 1. Installing the LearnMate Content Viewer

Follow the procedure below to install the LearnMate Content Viewer.

#### **1.1 Check Your Administration Privileges**

Administrator privileges are required to install the LearnMate Content Viewer.

Follow the steps below to check whether you have administrator privileges on a computer:

- 1. If you are using:
  - Windows 7, click the Windows **Start** button, then right-click the **All Programs** button.
  - An earlier version of Windows, right-click on the Windows **Start** button.
- 2. If you:
  - See an Open All Users option at the bottom of the menu, you have administrator rights on that PC.

Do not see an Open All Users option at the bottom of the menu, contact your IT Administrator either to assign you administrator rights or to perform the installation for you.

#### **1.2 Check the System Requirements**

Installation of the content viewer requires the following:

Note: Installation of Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 Full begins automatically if your computer does not already have that software framework. A setup window guides you through the installation process. Once Microsoft .NET Framework 4.0 Full is installed, you may have to restart your computer.

#### **1.3 Install the Content Viewer**

LearnMate Content Viewer can be installed automatically or manually.

#### **1.3.1 Automatic Installation**

Note: At any point in the installation process, click Back to review or change any of your installation settings.

To install the LearnMate Content Viewer automatically:

1. Insert the LearnMate Content Viewer DVD into the DVD drive. The AutoPlay window is displayed.



2. Click Run setup.exe. The installation process begins. Proceed to step 6.

To install the LearnMate Content Viewer manually:

1. In the disk folder, double-click the **Install** folder. The contents of the folder are displayed.



2. Double-click setup.exe.

The installation process begins.

**3.** If your computer does not have LearnMate Agent 5.X, it will be installed at this time. If LearnMate Agent 5.X is already installed, the wizard presents you with the option of modifying, repairing, or removing the software. If you do not wish to perform any of these actions, click **Cancel** and proceed to step 6.

The LearnMate Agent 5.X installation wizard opens. Click Next.



4. Click Install.

- Click Finish to exit the LearnMate Agent 5.X installation wizard. The Content Viewer installation procedure resumes.
- 6. Click Next.

### 2. Launching and Initial Setup

When launching the LearnMate Content Viewer for the first time, you are required to:

- Verify your license. See section 2.1, License Verification.
- Configure program settings. See section 2.2, Initial Setup.

#### **2.1 License Verification**

The LearnMate Content Viewer is protected by a licensing agreement. Upon opening the content viewer for the first time, you are asked to verify your license for the software. For more information, see the Intelitek Software Licensing Guide.

#### 2.2 Initial Setup

When running the content viewer for the first time, the Settings window is automatically displayed.

- 1. Close any open Internat Explorer windows. This step is necessary for the initial setup only, and not when using the LearnMate Content Viewer later on.
- **2.** Select both checkboxes.

Certain functions, such as text-to-speech narration may be inoperative if the checkboxes are not selected.

3. Click OK.
